

## Survey charges etc. as at 1 July 2010

The following hourly charges shall be laid down as at 1 July 2010 pursuant to Executive Order no. 293 of 15 April 2009 on the Payment for Surveys of Ships, etc., Executive Order no. 738 of 14 July 2005 on the Payment for Surveys of Ships etc. in Greenland and Executive Order no. 838 of 18 August 2008 on the Certificates confirming insurance or other financial security in respect of civil liability for bunker oil pollution damage

<b>Type of survey</b>	<b>Hourly charge (DKK)</b>
All statutory surveys of ships other than fishing vessels carried out in Denmark and Greenland, exclusive of the Faeroe Islands. Hourly charges are made for the time spent on surveys and case processing.	800.00
All statutory surveys of ships carried out abroad, inclusive of the Faeroe Islands. Hourly charges are made for the time spent on surveys, case processing and travelling. To this travel and accommodation expenses will be added.	800.00
Abortive travelling for surveys of all types of ships in Denmark, Greenland and the Faeroe Islands as well as abroad. Hourly charges will be made for the actual number of hours spent. To this travel and accommodation expenses will be added.	800.00
In connection with surveys in Greenland where the survey is carried out at the request of the customer without consideration for other survey activities organised by the Danish Maritime Authority's, charges may also be made for travelling time and for travel and accommodation expenses according to an estimate by the Danish Maritime Authority.	800.00
Surveys of fishing vessels where an agreed survey could not be carried out, had to be interrupted, or could not be completed within the fixed standard time due to the customer's conditions. Hourly charges are made for the time spent on surveys and case processing.	800.00
PSC surveys (port State control) in case of detention. Hourly charges are made for the time spent on surveys and case processing.	800.00
In connection with follow-up surveys of Danish ships abroad where detention took place after a PSC survey, hourly charges are made for the actual number of hours spent. To this expenses for travel and accommodation are added. If the survey is carried out in Denmark, hourly charges are made for the time spent on surveys and case processing.	800.00
In connection with surveys of ships at sea, separate charges are made for expenses for transport from land to the ship and back.	
In connection with extraordinary audits after marine casualties, industrial accidents or detentions, where there are signs of defects in the ISM systems. In connection with audits abroad, hourly charges are made for the actual number of hours spent. To this travel and accommodation expenses are added. In connection with audits in Denmark, hourly charges are made for the time spent on surveys and case processing.	800.00
Approval of marine equipment and vessels. Hourly charges are made for the time spent on surveys and case processing.	800.00
Approval and control of STS operators, audits of their quality management systems and control survey of STS operations. Hourly charges are made for the time spent on surveys and case processing.	800.00
Commercial activities, for example tasks which are not public authority tasks, such as consultancy surveys and the like, as well as the performance of surveys delegated to the classification societies. Hourly charges are made for the time spent on surveys, case processing and travelling. To this travel and accommodation expenses are added.	850.00

The statutory basis for charging payment for surveys is in section 24 of Consolidated Act no. 903 of 12 July 2007 on Safety at Sea

A 30-day credit period is normally granted in connection with invoicing. On late payments each issued reminder will be charged a fee of DKK 250. Also interest can be charged on late payments, at present 8.05 per cent p.a.
