Ship registration

The ship registry functions as a registry for ships. In order to raise a loan for financing a recreational craft, the lender (such as a financial institution) will normally require security for a mortgage through registration of a mortgage deed. The gross tonnage of the craft must be of or above 5 in order for the craft and consequently the mortgage deed to be registered.

Safety of navigation

The master of a recreational craft is obliged to make himself acquainted with the orders, regulations and sailing directions that apply to shipping in the waters in which the craft sails and at the places at which the craft calls. In addition, the provisions on watch-keeping also apply to yachtsmen. Further information about the conditions of navigation, etc. is available from navigational handbooks (such as "Navigation through Danish waters"/"Den danske lods" and "Den danske havnelods") and from charts.
