Order no. 839 of 29 September 1994 issued by the Ministry of Trade

Order on the access to carry on a profession in Danish ships for citizens from countries covered by the EEA agreement

In pursuance of section 2(1) of act no. 963 of 9 December 1992 on Denmark's accession to the Agreement on the European Economic Area (EEA Agreement), the following provisions are laid down:

Section 1. Section 13a of the act on the manning of ships (*lov om skibes besætning*), cf. consolidated act no. 105 of 7 February 1994 on the manning of ships, on EU citizens' access to carry on a profession shall also apply to citizens from countries covered by the EEA Agreement. Such access shall be conditional upon the relevant persons meeting the requirements of the Directives of the European Communities on the introduction of general schemes for mutual recognition of examination certificates for qualifying training programmes, cf. act no. 291 of 8 May 1991 on access to carry on certain professions in Denmark for citizens of the European Communities and the Nordic countries, with the adjustments that are a consequence of the EEA Agreement.

Section 2. This order shall enter into force on 15 October 1994.
