Order no. 1119 of 24 October 2008 issued by the Danish Maritime Authority

Order on promulgation of regulations issued under the Act on Safety at Sea

In pursuance of section 17(6) of the Act on Safety at Sea, cf. consolidated Act no. 903 of 12 July 2007, and by authority of the Danish Minister of Economic and Business Affairs, the following provisions are laid down:

Section 1. Regulations issued in pursuance of the Act on Safety at Sea shall be promulgated in the Danish Law Gazette (*Lovtidende*) unless expressly provided otherwise in sections 2-6 of this Order.

Section 2. The Danish Maritime Authority may decide that rules, measures and general and specific prohibitions or injunctions issued in pursuance of section 6 of the Act on Safety at Sea shall be promulgated in the Danish Notices to Mariners (*Efterretninger for Søfarende*).

Section 3. An overview of the prescribed contents of ship's medicine chests shall be promulgated by placing the overview electronically on the webpage of the Danish Maritime Authority or for inspection at the premises of the Danish Maritime Authority.

Section 4. International resolutions referred to in the technical regulations issued by the Danish Maritime Authority shall be promulgated by placing the said international resolutions electronically on the webpage of the Danish Maritime Authority or for inspection at the premises of the Danish Maritime Authority.¹

Section 5. Rules referred to in the technical regulations issued by the Danish Maritime Authority and stipulated by recognised classification societies on the construction, equipment and operation of ships shall not be promulgated in the Danish Law Gazette (*Lovtidende*), but are available for sale from the relevant classification societies.

Section 6. Rules referred to in the technical regulations issued by the Danish Maritime Authority and stipulated by standardisation organisations on the construction, equipment and operation of ships shall not be promulgated in the Danish Law Gazette (*Lovtidende*), but are available for sale from the relevant standardisation organisations.

Section 7. This Order shall enter into force on 1 December 2008.

Subsection 2. Order no. 952 of 14 September 2006 on the promulgation of regulations issued under the Danish Act on Safety at Sea shall be repealed.
