Order no. 1196 of 14 December 2011 issued by the Danish Tele-Authority

**Order on fees in 2012 for tests, certificates,
call signs and identification numbers**

In pursuance of section 51(1) of act no. 475 of 12 June 2009 on radio frequencies, the following provisions are laid down:

Fees

Section 1. For tests, for the issuance of copies of certificates and for the assigning of call signs in the amateur radio and amateur radio satellite service, a fee shall be paid to the Danish Commerce Agency as follows:

- 1) Amateur radio test: DKK 491 per test.
- 2) Copy of certificate: DKK 84 per copy.
- 3) Issuance of call sign: DKK 343.

Section 2. For radio tests for acquiring an SRC certificate (Short Range Certificate) for operating maritime VHF radio installations, for the issuance of copies of certificates and for assigning call signs or identification numbers in maritime radio services, a fee shall be paid to the Danish Maritime Authority as follows:

- 1) SRC certificate: DKK 514 per test.
- 2) Copy of certificate: DKK 84 per copy.
- 3) Assigning call sign or identification number: DKK 735.

Section 3. For the issuance of call signs or identification numbers to users of radio frequencies in aeronautical radio services in Danish registered aircraft or on earth stations, a fee shall be paid to the Danish Transport Authority as follows: DKK 343.

Subsection 2. For the issuance of identification numbers to users of radio frequencies in aeronautical radio services in ultra-light aircraft, a fee shall be paid to the Danish Ultralight Aircraft Union as follows: DKK 343.

Subsection 3. For the issuance of identification numbers to users of radio frequencies in aeronautical radio services in hang-gliders, including motorised hang-gliders, and para-gliders, a fee shall be paid to the Danish Hang-gliding and Para-gliding Union as follows: DKK 343.

Subsection 4. If fees pursuant to subsections 1-3 are not received after the last timely date of payment, an administrative fee may be required paid for each reminder as follows: DKK 99.

Entry into force

Section 4. This order shall enter into force on 1 January 2012.

Subsection 2. Order no. 1141 of 4 December 2009 on deposits when announcing radio frequencies and on the fees of the Danish National IT and Telecom Agency in 2010 shall be repealed.
