Annual Report on activities in accordance with Regulation 5.1.4, paragraph 13

Danish Maritime Authority (DMA)

Reporting period 1 January 2018 to 31 December 2018

This report is published under the MLC, 2006 (regulation 5.1.4, paragraph 13) and summarizes statistics on the annual inspection activities accordingly for the period from 1 January 2018 to 31 December 2018.

Recruitment and placement:

The DMA did not approve any private recruitment and placement services for seafarers in Denmark in 2018. Currently, the DMA has approved 3 private recruitment and placement services in total. For further information, please click [here](#).

Seafarer complaints:

The DMA has received thirteen on-shore complaints (regulation 5.2.2) in 2018. Five of the complaints were related to non-Danish ships. One of the complaints resulted in FSI detention of a non-Danish vessel due to missing crew payment.

The DMA has developed an electronic form for handling complaints. The form can be used by seafarers, Recognized Organizations (ROs), Port State Control Officers (PSCOs) or other reporting parties such as port authorities, the police and ITF. For further information, please click [here](#).
