## Order amending the Order on Notice A from the Danish Maritime Authority, Technical regulation on Working Environment in ships

## Section 1

Order no. 1246 of 11 December 2009 on Notice A from the Danish Maritime Authority A, Technical regulation on Working Environment in ships, as last amended by order no. 121 of 20 January 2021, is amended as follows:

- 1. Chapter X, part A, regulation 1, paragraph 2, is amended from »9 days after the occurrence of the damage« to: »14 days after the first day of absence, if the accident has resulted in absence from the usual work of the injured parties, in addition to day of injury«
- **2.** In Chapter X, part A, regulation 1, following is inserted as paragraph 2.1 and 2.2:
- **»2.1** Accidents at work which have not resulted in absences, but which are assumed to be capable of justifying claims for benefits under § 11 of the Occupational Injury Insurance Act, the master of the ship must be notified within 14 days of the day of the injury.«
- **»2.2** For vessels resident in Greenland, accidents at work etc. shall be reported to the Danish Maritime Authority as soon as possible and no later than 9 days after the occurrence of the damage, cf. the Act on occupational injury insurance in Greenland.«

## Section 2

The Order enters into force on 1 July 2022.
