

**Order amending the order on reporting of information  
on dangerous or polluting goods on board ships<sup>1</sup>**

**Section 1**

In order no. 1349 of 15 December 2011 on reporting of information on dangerous or polluting goods on board ships, as amended by order no. 209 of 1 March 2012, the following amendments shall be made:

1. The *footnote* to the title of the order shall be as follows:

“1) This order contains provisions implementing parts of European Parliament and Council Directive 2002/59/EC of 27 June 2002 establishing a Community vessel traffic monitoring and information system within the Community and repealing Council Directive 93/75/EEC, Official Journal 2002 L 208, page 10, as amended by European Parliament and Council directive 2009/17/EC of 23 April 2009, Official Journal 2009 no. L 131, page 101, and Commission Directive 2011/15/EU of 23 February 2011, Official Journal 2011, no. L 49, p. 33, as well as European Parliament and Council Directive 2010/65/EU of 20 October 2010 on reporting formalities for ships arriving in and/or departing from ports of the Member States and repealing Directive 2002/6/EC, Official Journal 2010 no. L 283, pp. 1-10.”

2. *Section 4(3)* shall be as follows:

“The information mentioned in subsections 1-2 shall be reported electronically via SafeSeaNet.

**Section 2**

This order shall enter into force on 19 May 2012.
