

Translation: Only the Danish document has legal validity

Order no. 1259 of 9 December 2004 issued by the Ministry Science, Technology and Innovation

**Order on the transfer of certain powers
to the Danish Maritime Authority**

In pursuance of section 42(1) and (2), cf. section 29(1), second clause, (2) and (3) and section 30 and section 49(1) and (2) of the act on radio frequencies (*lov om radiofrekvenser*), cf. consolidated act no. 680 of 23 June 2004, the following provisions are laid down:

Section 1. The Danish Maritime Authority is authorised to issue and revoke Short Range Certificates (SRCs) for the operation of maritime VHF radio installations when an exam has been passed.

Section 2. The Danish Maritime Authority is authorised to lay down more detailed regulations on tests as mentioned in section 1.

Subsection 2. The regulations may cover the contents of the tests and the arrangement of tests and their validity.

Subsection 3. The Danish Maritime Authority is authorised to lay down special regulations for disabled persons' sitting for tests as mentioned in section 1.

Subsection 4. The Danish Maritime Authority is authorised to lay down regulations whereby tests mentioned in section 1 arranged by other public authorities, including foreign authorities, and by private persons and companies are recognised.

Section 3. For radio tests for acquiring certificates for the operation of maritime VHF radio installations as mentioned in section 1, fees shall be paid by the following amounts:

- 1) SRC certificate – DKK 525.00.
- 2) Copy of certificate – DKK 85.00.

Section 4. The Danish Maritime Authority is authorised to issue and revoke call signs and other identification numbers for use when using radio frequencies in maritime radio services in ships registered in Denmark.

Section 5. The Danish Maritime Authority is authorised to lay down more detailed regulations on the issuance of call signs and other identification numbers as mentioned in section 4.

Section 6. For the issuance of individual call signs to users of radio frequencies as mentioned in section 4, fees are payable by the following amounts:

- 1) Issuance of call signs for ships – DKK 750.00.

Section 7. This order shall enter into force on 1 January 2005.
