

**Declaration on the performance of intermediate surveys through
self-monitoring on commercial vessels carrying up to 12 passengers
with scantlings of or above 20, but below 100 and with a length below 15 metres, as well as
with scantlings below 20, but with power output above 100 kW**

It is hereby declared that, in an intermediate survey held on the following date, the ship:

- is operated in accordance with good seamanship and that human lives at sea have been secured in a fully safe manner;

- is operated in accordance with the ship's safety instructions in force.
- The safety instructions have been scrutinized to ensure that it continues to reflect the navigations activities for which the ship is used.
- also meets any new provisions that have become effective since the last survey;
- is seaworthy and operated in accordance with the provisions on protection of the marine environment;
- is arranged so that it is possible to carry out the work on board in manner that is fully appropriate in terms of health and safety;
- has not been re-built or significantly altered since the last survey by the Danish Maritime Authority.

Furthermore, it is declared that there have been no occupational or marine accidents on board the ship that must be reported since the last survey.

The Danish Maritime Authority must receive the declaration no later than 14 days before the date of the intermediate survey as stated in the Permit to carry passengers. If this deadline is exceeded, a trade permit cannot be renewed on the basis of a self-monitoring.
