## Order for the Faroe Islands on a special liability limit for ships below 300 tonnes for claims other than claims related to personal injury or deaths

In pursuance of section 175(6), the second sentence, of the merchant shipping act ( $s\phi loven$ ), as enacted for the Faroe Islands by royal decree no. 187 of 8 February 2017, the following provisions are laid down by authority:

**Section 1.** The liability limit stipulated in section 175(3) of the merchant shipping act ( $s\phi loven$ ), as enacted for the Faroe Islands by royal decree no. 187 of 8 February 2017, shall be set at:

- 1) 775,000 SDR for ships with a gross tonnage of and below 100 tonnes; and
- 2) 1 million SDR for ships with a gross tonnage from 101 to 299 tonnes.

**Section 2.** This order shall enter into force on 1 March 2017.
